Classroom work is acceptable, but must be artist's original concept. **Entries must be suitably framed, equipped with wire, ready to hang. No more than 36" wide. No more than 75 pounds. Three dimensional works must be self-supporting or have companion stand.** Lincoln Days, Inc. will exercise the right to reject any work. Lincoln Days, Inc. will exercise care for all works received, but cannot accept financial liability and will not provide insurance. Entry fee must be made payable to: Lincoln Days Art Show. Judging of the Lincoln Division and the Open Division will be conducted by a qualified, experienced member(s) of the art field. SALE ART: Lincoln Days promotes the sale of works featured in the show to local residents/businesses and to visitors. A 10% COMMISSION on all sales will be retained by Lincoln Days, Inc. If a work is FOR SALE the price must be indicated on the Entry Form. The placing of a price by the artist will be taken as permission to sell the work at that price should it not be The Purchase Award Winner. If a work is NOT FOR SALE, ""NFS"" MUST be written on the entry form.
